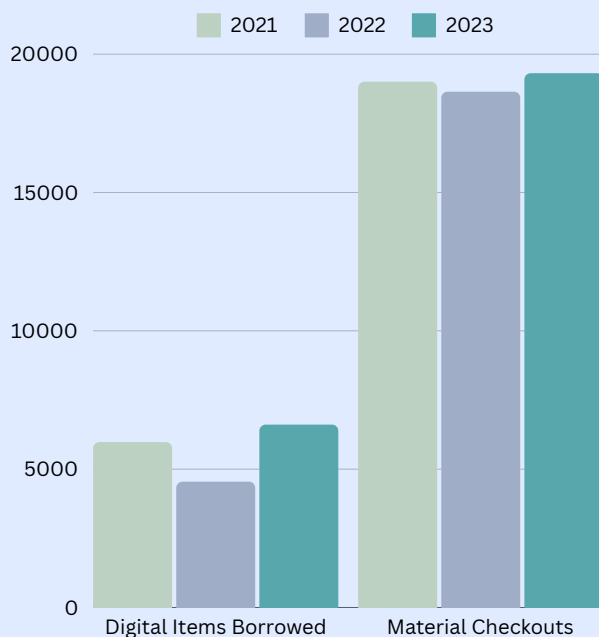

From the Manager:

In 2023 the Marion Library saw an increase of 51% in program attendance compared with the previous year, and our summer reading program had the highest number of registrants ever. We are grateful to Lollypops & Polkadots, County Line Animal Hospital, Sheriff Milby, Wayne County Dairy Ambassadors, and the Wayne County Fair Organization for their time and contributions, which made our summer activities extra special. The StoryWalk at the Town Park was back for its second year, featuring three different books.

We loaned STEAM kits for kids, a Pickleball Paddle set, and added an additional NYS Empire Park Pass. Patrons helped themselves to the free jig-saw puzzle exchange, yarn library for crafters, seed library, and we hosted a plant exchange swap in January.

Partnering with local organizations such as the Marion Food Pantry, Marion Central School District, Wayne County Department of Health, Rochester Regional Mobile Mammogram, we were able to connect patrons with valuable resources. Our community is stronger when people have access to services and materials they need to pursue their educational, career, family, and life goals.
