The OWWL Library System serves an area of approximately 2,500 square miles across Ontario, Wayne, Wyoming, and Livingston counties.

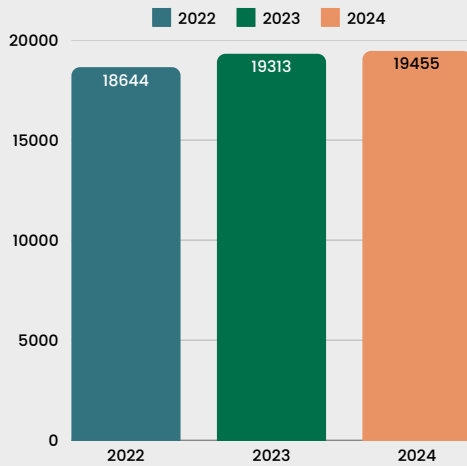

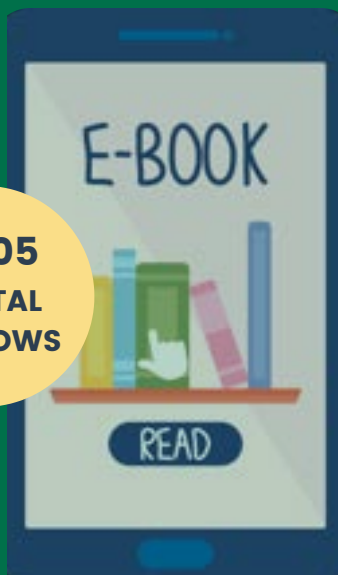

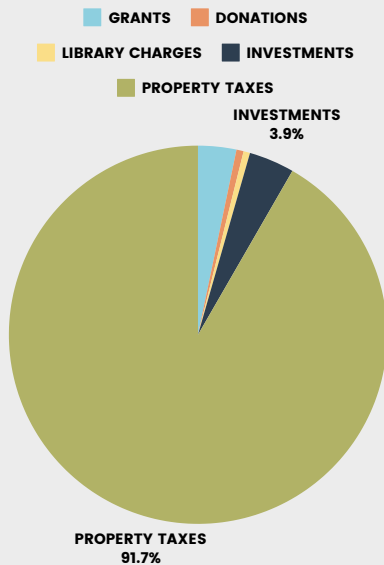

- We attempt to fill the informational, recreational, cultural and educational needs of our users, and to encourage non-users to avail themselves of our services.



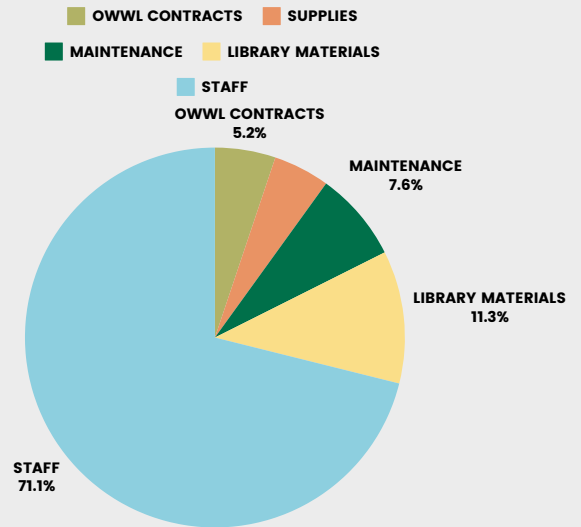
