The 2025-2026 funding proposition for the library’s school district tax support represents an increase of 1%. This translates to an increase in library tax of approximately \$.60 per year for a home assessed at \$100,000.

Important information about the vote:

- Must be a resident of the Newark Central School District
- Must be 18 years of age or older to vote.
- You do not have to be registered before May 20. You can fill out a form at the voting booth the day of the vote.
- You can vote on the library’s funding proposition on Tuesday, May 20, from 9AM to 8PM at the Newark High School, 625 Peirson Avenue.
- Applications for absentee ballots can be picked up from 9AM to 4PM Monday through Friday at the Newark Central School District Office, 100 East Miller Street. The school district office must receive completed applications at least seven (7) days before the vote and election.
- The library will hold a budget hearing on Thursday, May 8 from 6-6:30PM to allow voters to learn more about the library’s budget and ask questions.

Trustee Election

Two Trustee’s terms are expiring on June 30, 2025, Ms. Sue Oberdorf and Mr. Joseph Nicosia, both are running for re-election.
