The Bloomfield Public Library has proposed a 2 cent tax increase per \$1,000 in assessed property value. A vote will be held on Tuesday, May 16th from 7AM-8PM at the back galleria of the high school on Oakmout Avenue. If passed, the cost to the average household will increase by \$2.50 per year.
