

Caledonia Library Cancels Programs and Events until mid-April

As a precaution, and to help protect the community and staff, the Caledonia Library has canceled all programs and events until mid-April. Library staff members will continue to be in contact with local health officials and will make changes as necessary.

Please be advised that if you are experiencing flu-like symptoms and do not feel well, you should stay home. If you are ill and unable to return library materials, please be aware that you will not incur any fines. Our concern is your health and well-being.

The Caledonia Library is taking these steps to assure your health in the library:

- Wiping surfaces daily, including handrails, door handles, desks, and computer equipment.
- For now, children's toys will not be available.
- Materials will be sanitized upon return.
- Employees are following good hygiene practices by frequently washing hands and staying home when ill.
