# Funding

The main source of funding for the Wolcott Library is from the annual Library Proposition at \$108,000. This is the majority of the library budget, in regard to public funding. It is not part of the school budget. There is no longer any library funding from the Village of Wolcott, Town of Butler, Town of Huron, Town of Wolcott, and Wayne County.

Other funding sources consist of money "donations" for memberships, fines, book and DVD sales, copies, faxes and memorials. We also receive a few donations from local businesses.
